

## Ring guide to print actual size

It is important that your ring guide is printed actual size, format 100%, in order to avoid distorting the measurements. To verify this, please make use of a ruler to ensure the scale here measures exactly 5cm.



### Step 1: Measure the circumference of your finger

Take a band or ring (preferably a wedding ring) that you can place on the finger that you will wear your new ring on.

### Step 2: Choose the right size.

Simply place the band or ring on the table of measures below. If the black line matches the interior of the band, it is the correct finger circumference for you.
